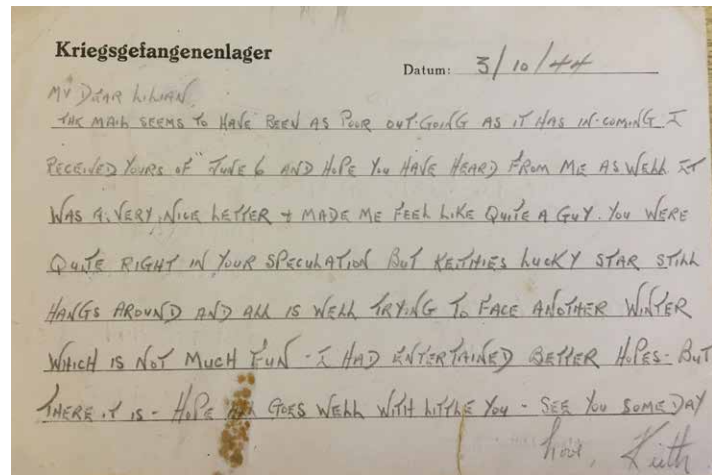


Postcard from Keith to Lilian
